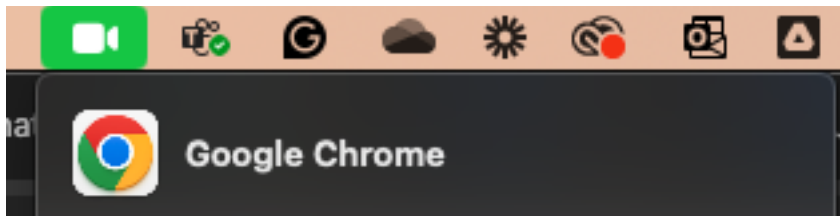


How to Disable the Reaction Feature on a Video Conferencing Tool for Mac

This guide will assist you in disabling the reaction feature in your video conferencing tool on a Mac. Reactions include emojis such as thumbs up or clapping hands, which can be triggered manually or automatically through gestures.

1. Open the Video Settings

- Launch any video conferencing application on your Mac.
- Click on the green camera icon in the top menu bar of your Mac.



2. Disable the Reactions Settings

2. Click on "Reactions" to deactivate the Mac Reactions features.
